Saturday Nahwatzel SIP Spectator

After Parc Expose head to the first spectator stage of Nahwatzel. First car out will be at **10:25 am** so plenty of time to get from downtown Shelton to the location. Nahwatzel will run twice with the second running starting at **1:25pm**. Each running will take about 1.5 to 2 hours.

For you the spectators we have asked several local food trucks including Radio Fryer Foods to come out so they will be available to purchase food from. There will also be restrooms available at the location.

Saturday Stillwater Spectator Location

After Nahwatzel head to the afternoon stage of Stillwater. First car out will be at **4:35 pm**. Stillwater will run twice with the second running starting at **7:14 pm**. Each running will take about 1.5 to 2 hours.

We have one location for this stage but lots of area to Park. The location for parking is on a loop so please follow directions on how to get in and where to park. There will be some walking so put on your walking/hiking shoes. Also this stage is late in the day so flash lights are recommended along with warm clothing. To get to the stage after Nahwatzel get back on Shelton Matlock road and head east. Turn right on W Highland Rd. Entrance to the spectator location is about 3.4 miles on the right. Once you make it, there will be signs and volunteers to guide you.

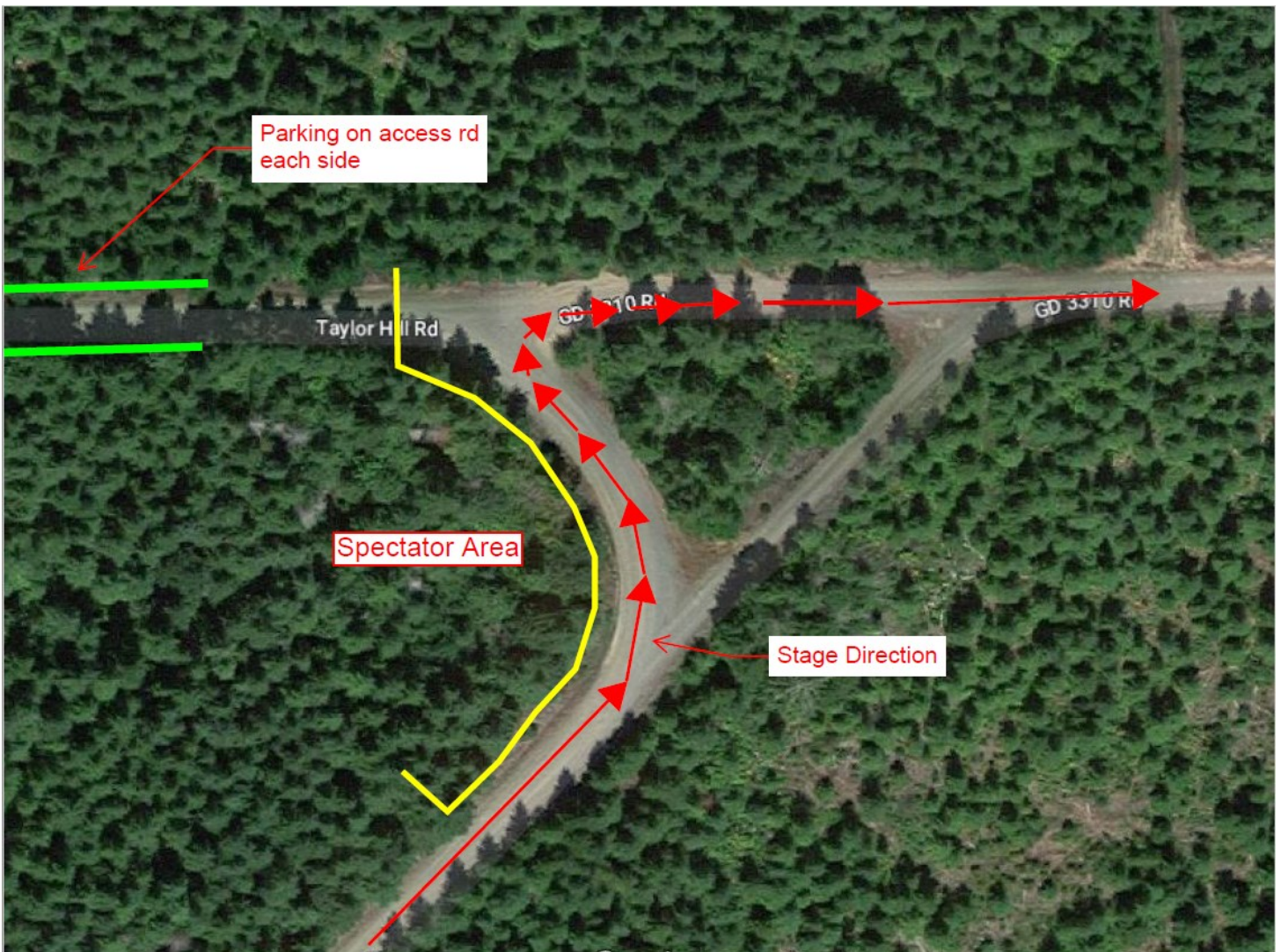




Sunday Wildcat Spectator Location

After Fred Meyer Parc Expose head to the morning stage of Wildcat. First car out will be at **9:50 am**. Wildcat will run twice with the second running starting at **12:42 pm**. Each running will take about 1.5 to 2 hours. The location is close to the end of the stage, which is long at 18.65 miles, so if you don't get out to the spectator location right away not to worry. Google says it will take you about 20 minutes from Parc Expose to this location

Those that have come to Wildcat in years past may not recognize this location. Our traditional location, due to tree growth, just doesn't work anymore. This location has a good stretch the cars will come down before they go around this delta just for you to enjoy. Enter into the area on Taylor Hill Road off Cloquallum Road. Sunday SIP Spectator Loca-

For the final stages of the rally we go back to the Stillwater Industrial Park (SIP). There will be 2 running's of the stage but each is a little different. All competitors will run the first time, the second is a power stage that only National Competitors will run. First Car out is at **3:19 pm** and the second running starting at **5:34 pm**. The Stage is 4.75 miles long and in a different configuration than Nahwatzel, you'll be able to see all the competitors that reach the finish line of the rally.

We have asked Radio Fryer food trucks to come back for Sunday as well so you can stick around and get some food. Restrooms will also still be available at the location.
